2019 Ossabaw Island Pig Roast & Art Auction

On **Saturday, October 26, 2019**, The Ossabaw Island Foundation will host our 18th annual Ossabaw Island Pig Roast & Art Auction. **The Ossabaw Island Foundation (TOIF) seeks donations of Ossabaw Island-inspired artwork to be sold in the silent auction at the Pig Roast**, our organization's only fundraiser. All types of visual art and fine crafts are welcomed – paintings, drawings, photography, sculpture, mixed media, wood turning, etc.

Any artist who has spent time on Ossabaw is invited to contribute a work of art (minimum value \$195) for this signature annual event. Each donating artist is eligible to receive one (1) complimentary ticket for this year's event. As in past years, we have reserved fifty (50) 2019 Pig Roast tickets for contributing artists, available on a first come, first serve basis. You may claim your one (1) artist ticket when the art is received in our office.

Thank you for your generosity to the Ossabaw Island Foundation. We are grateful for the artwork donated each year. The art auction, and the attendance by contributing artists, is a vital part of the magic of the Pig Roast.

Art Contributions to The Ossabaw Island Foundation (TOIF) Pig Roast (The Fine Print—2019 Edition)

1. **ONLY ONE DONATED PIECE PER ARTIST.** This assures that our art auction reflects the variety of media and style created by Ossabaw's artistic community.
2. **Market value of donated artwork.** We ask that donated artwork be an estimated market value of at least \$195.
3. **Artwork submission and use of art by TOIF.** The Ossabaw Island Foundation's art auction is NOT a juried event. All donated art is gratefully accepted by TOIF, with the understanding that TOIF will put each piece of art to use in such a way that is of the greatest benefit for the organization, and the best "fit" for the piece. Occasionally some works are placed for long-term display in the Clubhouse, the Boarding House, or the TOIF offices. Some works may be used as gifts for TOIF board members or longtime supporters of the island. These decisions are made at the sole discretion of TOIF.
4. **Artwork submission requirements.**
 - *Labeling.* We ask that each piece of artwork be clearly labeled, on the back or underside if possible. Labeling should include: Name of artist. Title of piece. Estimated market price of piece. Contact information of the artist (for the benefit of the buyer.) This may include a business card with website, etc.
 - *Framing or presentation.* We ask that donated work already be framed (if applicable to the piece).
 - *Optional: JPEG image.* We are asking for artists to submit a .jpeg image of the donated work. TOIF will post some images of the artwork on our website and Facebook page to encourage interest in the event, and to showcase some of the wonderful art made in response to the experience of Ossabaw.
5. **Art donation receipt.** When your art is delivered to TOIF, you will receive a receipt for the work. This receipt also serves as your tax letter.
6. **Information on art purchaser.** After the Pig Roast, artists may request the name of the purchaser of their artwork. We do not provide the final purchase price. This letter will ONLY be sent to those artists who request it after October 26. You may email robin@ossabawisland.org after the auction for this information.
7. **Pig Roast tickets for artists:** Each contributing artist is eligible to receive one (1) complimentary ticket to that year's Pig Roast event, a \$195 value. Fifty (50) tickets are available for contributing artists.
8. **Artist Pig Roast tickets are not transferable.** The ticket may only be used by the artist; it may not be transferred to a friend or relative. The ticket is only valid for this year's event; it may not be transferred to a future year's Pig Roast.
9. **Claiming your artist ticket to the Pig Roast.** Artist ticket may be claimed when the artwork is delivered to the Ossabaw Island Foundation office. No ticket reservations will be available until the artwork is delivered. All contributing artist tickets are distributed first-come first-serve, and artist tickets are not "set aside" until formally requested.
10. **Boat time for artist tickets.** Each artist who receives a Pig Roast ticket will be assigned a boat time (approximately 11am departure). Exception: artists who attend with guests who purchased general admission tickets or sponsor tickets can be scheduled for the same boat time as those guests.
