Pursuant to a Warrant from his Excellency Henry Ellis, Esq^r Captain General & Governor in Chief in & over his Majesty's said Province to his deputed bearing date the 2^d Day of Septem^r 1760. We have caused to be delineated & laid out unto Grey Elliot Esq^r the Island Barbados purchased by him at Public Auction the 17th day of May 1760. for the sum of One thousand, three hundred & twenty five pounds Sterling (exclusive of the duties & charges thereon) by order of his Excellency the Governor. bounded to the Southward by the Ocean, to the Northward by Great Cockeye River, to the Westward by marshes Creeks & branches leading from St. Catherine's Sound. It is a Southern branch of Great Cockeye River, is situate in the parish of St. Philip & contains seven thousand six hundred Acres, having such form, natural & artificial Marshes as are above expressed & delineated by the above delineated plan thereof. Certified the 31st day of September in the Year of our Lord sixteen hundred & sixty
